## **Visiting Puerto Rico by Boat**

Boats arriving from outside the territory must contact customs immediately upon arrival. The regional offices are open Monday to Saturday, 0800-1200 and 1300-1700. Yachts arriving after business hours, Sunday, or holidays, must report their arrival by contacting US Customs Service at tel: 787-253-4538. American yachts coming from the US Virgin Islands must clear customs on arrival in Puerto Rico the same as other yachts. US boats can do this by telephone provided they have paid the annual \$25 customs fee. (Customs information provided by Noonsite)
