### Old Port Cove Marina

North Palm Beach, FL

The Palm Beaches offer boaters world-class dining and entertainment coupled with history and convenience. Always a favorite destination for Marinalife members, the recent renovation of Old Port Cove Marina in North Palm Beach, entices boaters with an even better reason to visit.

Old Port Cove Marina is north of the Palm Beach Inlet, 9 miles north of West Palm Beach and minutes from some of the finest fishing and cruising grounds in Florida and is an excellent "jumping-off" spot to the Bahamas. The recently completed \$7 million renovation to its North Marina allows accommodations for approximately 55 vessels up to 190 feet. Starting last spring, the renovations include replacement of all docks, piers and pilings with beautiful new state-of-the-art hard wood decked floating docks. The marina also features new power pedestals with 100 amp single and 3 phase electric, cable, phone, WIFI, and the convenience of in-slip pump-out. Old Port Cove knows how to cater to the visiting boater with additional marina services including a ship's store, showers, laundry, on-site car rental, mail service, e-mail, fax, UPS, and concierge services. The marina location also offers easy access to great shopping and restaurants. In addition, Old Port Cove Marina will offer special membership packages to the Old Port Yacht Club for those that want to experience the old world charm of the yacht club.

"This latest renovation demonstrates just how dedicated we are to providing the best in accommodations for our clients," said Rick Morgan, President and C.O.O. "This five-star facility is the first of its kind to allow mega-yacht owners access to the Palm Beaches. Old Port Cove Holdings has also renovated its two sister properties, North Palm Beach Marina and New Port Cove Marine Center. The North Palm Beach Marina, located between the north end of Lake Worth and the U.S. #1 Parker Bridge features new hard wood decked floating docks, a quiet, sheltered, secure harbor, a ship store, gas and diesel fuel as well as a heated, olympic size pool, golf, driving range, clay tennis courts, restaurants, and shopping, all within walking distance. The New Port Cove Marine Center, located on the mainland across from the Palm Beach Inlet, has 43 wet slips up to 70 feet and a 300 dry storage bay for boats up to 40 feet. The facility also has on-site mechanical service, custom built fork lift, secured parking, restrooms, showers, laundry, marina store, gas & diesel fuel pumped from floating docks, and pump-out service. The storage building is rated to withstand winds up to 144 MPH. [ml](#)
