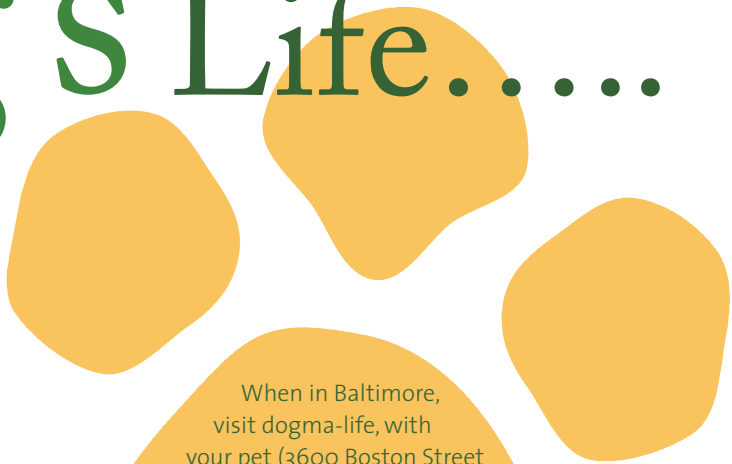


It's a Dog's Life.....
